George Lasley reported that have 101 tables reserved for November's show at the fairgrounds.

George read the letter, concerning the conflict between our fair and the “City Votes Marathon” on November 6th, which he prepared to be sent to Raleigh’s Mayor, City Council and Police Department. There was a unanimous approval of the letter.

We may also have an inaugural dinner; as last year.

John Held introduced the “programs” for the membership meetings that he runs for the club. He asked for suggestions from, and participation by, our members.

Steve Wills provided a Treasurer’s Report. Our position is effectively a bit ahead from a year ago. Pricing was determined for Frank Mansfield’s used HO track; \$1 for brass, \$5 for nickel-silver. We have a donation of brass HO track and Joe Johnston has had several phone calls about N scale equipment. Bernie Dawson will contact the N scale donor(s).

Tom Magnani was provided with an annotated 2010-2011 Club Roster Dues listing dated 03/26/11 to contact those members, by email and post, who either are, or will be, in arrears on their dues.

George Lasley reported on his conversation, in response to the Club's letter concerning the conflict with the coincidentally scheduled foot race on 11/6/11, with a representative of the Raleigh Police. He had suggested an alternate route near the Fairgrounds and was told that a change in the route will require certification by the Boston Marathon organization as this is a qualifying race for that event. He also informed the Police contact that their signage requires considerable improvement over last year's to be clear to those who are not intimately familiar with the local streets round the Fairground. He has not received any response from any of the City Council members; although each member was sent an individual letter.

George Lasley also reported on his brief visit with Roland Waggoner.

Frank Simmons reported that the three (3) "At Large" Board members have received their telephone contact lists. Their report is due on April 20th. He has been auditing the Treasurer's books; considering them from a Statement of Purpose, Statement of Opinion, perspective and has been in contact with Steve.

Joe Johnston announced that he has set up an IR (Infra Red) link in the inside of the HO layout that can be connected to from most of the layout by the Digitrax Controllers. Additionally, he and Don Jennings have been doing repairs and upgrades to the layout's wiring. J. R. thanked both for their work.

John Held reported that George will present a talk on air brushing at our next members meeting.

Frank Simmons completed the additional library shelving.
